## **ATLANTIC BEACH RESCUE**

### **Standard Operating Guideline-**

#### **MEMBERSHIP:**

- Junior Membership is available to individuals ages 14 through 18 who reside in Atlantic Beach, including summer residents, and who attend or have graduated from high school or a similar secondary educational facility.
- Junior Membership is conditioned upon maintaining a minimum of a “C” or 2.0 GPA overall average. The Chief reserves the right to contact your school to confirm compliance with this provision. Failure to comply with this provision will result with your suspension of this program until such time the required GPA is attained.

#### **ADVISORY BOARD:**

- The Junior Membership program is supervised by an Advisory Board that consists of three members of the Atlantic Beach Rescue including the Chief of the Department, the Medical Captain and one member appointed by the Chief of the Department. The Advisory Board shall, in conjunction, with the Line Officers, establish and oversee training and procedures of the Junior Members. The Advisory Board will also assist in planning and supervising field trips and other activities involving the Junior Members.
- The Board of Advisors shall periodically review the Rules and Regulations of the Program and shall, along with the Chief of Department, be responsible for the enforcement of all rules, regulations and procedures. The Board of Advisors shall have the power to immediately suspend a Junior Member for any infraction pending a formal review before the Chief of the Department. .

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- Junior Members are not permitted in headquarters without an active senior member of the Atlantic Beach Rescue accompanying them. Juniors must leave Headquarters by 9:00PM Sunday through Thursday during the school year. The only exception to the above is for scheduled school and legal holidays.
- Junior Members are permitted unaccompanied in the backroom ready area only and must be accompanied by an active member on the apparatus floor at all times.
- Junior Members are expected to conduct themselves at all times in a manner that will not bring embarrassment to the Atlantic Beach Rescue.
- The Chief of Department shall have the sole authority to affect discipline upon any Junior member.
- Junior Members shall not respond to alarms.

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- Junior Members will be issued tee shirts, which shall be worn during meetings and drills. (Note: Junior Members may wear these at any other time but are to remember that they are representing Atlantic Beach Rescue and should conduct themselves accordingly.)
