  - A. A Residential District "A" the radius map shall be 200 feet.
  - B. Marine Recreation District "MR" the radius map shall be 500 feet
  - C. In "A" and "CA" districts that have non-residential structures, proposed use changes to non-residential and residential uses the radius map shall be 500 feet.
- 8. Completed Environmental Assessment form (one copy).
- 9. Applicant shall prepare all envelopes with proper postage as follows:
  - A. Certified mail, return receipt requested for all properties abutting subject property.
  - B. First class postage for all property owners with the required radius map.
